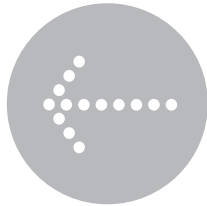

Dig deeper into the person of Jesus by studying seven stories from the life of Jesus, as told in the gospel of John. This is a 7-week study.

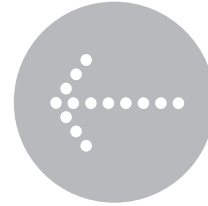
### 3 CREED
